Freedom Day

On Freedom Day, 25th March, there will be celebrations all over the world, making a stand against modern day slavery and Trafficking. This will be the 200th anniversary of the abolition of the Transatlantic Slave Trade. Surprisingly today, there are more trafficked and enslaved people in the world than ever before in history. Even more horrifying is that there are estimated to be 8.4 million children caught in slavery and trafficking.

Over the last year we have been planning several Global Angels concerts in the UK followed by one in Times Square, New York, and Washington, to raise awareness of the trafficking situation and to raise funds to help support outstanding projects that are rescuing and rehabilitating trafficked children.

Stop the Traffik - Voice of Slavery Concert, 25th March

Christian Elliott, our creative director, is helping to produce the Voice of Slavery Concert in London on Freedom Day. Global Angels is one of the leading steering group committee members of the Stop the Traffik Global Coalition. March 25th, 2007, marks the bicentenary of the British parliamentary act to abolish the Transatlantic slave trade. Right across Britain, there will be commemorations of this historic event. This will provide a unique opportunity for those organisations working on the issue of contemporary slavery to get their voices heard.

Voice of Slavery is an organisation producing an album with top international artists singing real slave songs from the past, to raise funds in support of organisations such as Stop the Traffik. Daniel will be compering the concert, alongside Sadie Frost and Samantha Morton. On this date,

the event will be held at the Kentish Town Forum. This will bring together many musicians, poets and artists including Razorlight, Supergrass, Finley Quaye, Ed Harcourt, Emmanuel Jal and other extra special guests to be confirmed.

Stop Trafficking Children

Daniel was on the Heaven and Earth show last Sunday speaking about child trafficking and the Stop the Traffik Campaign. This Sunday, Natasha will be speaking about her trip to Mumbai to meet street children and young girls rescued out of prostitution in her role as a Global Angels Ambassador. Did you know that just under 50% of all the cocoa used in the world today is produced by "chocolate slaves" – children who have been trafficked from their homes and the streets and forced into slave labour in the cocoa plantations of the Cote D'or in West Africa. It is fact that at least 15,000 Malian children alone have been trafficked into cocoa production in Cote D'or, suffering the harshest forms of child labour. These figures are only a conservative estimate and hardly touch the surface of the actual numbers.
